PRIMITIVE AND MODERN CAMPS WILL BE SEPARATED**

During the rendezvous, vehicles will be allowed in the primitive camp to unload only. Please limit this time to 1 hour. **No vehicles are allowed in the primitive area to load prior to completion of prizing on Sunday. ATVs are prohibited in primitive area from sundown Wednesday until after prizing on Sunday.** Keep modern items out of sight while camping in the primitive area. **You are responsible for your children and pets.** Destructive or abusive behavior will not be tolerated. Pets not on a leash may be served at the pot luck.

Trail walks will be done as a team and will include knowledge and skills to be answered as a group. Trail walk events require a shooter’s fee plus a blanket prize (\$15.00 + value). An extra blanket prize may be required for trade gun trail walk. The trade gun trail walk requires a trade gun (54 caliber or larger smooth bore flintlock), throwing knife, and hawk. The dress points, skills, and knowledge portion will be done immediately before or after the trail walk. All individuals are responsible for and must turn in their own score cards.

Be prepared for a closed fire season. Bring a fire bucket, a shovel and an ax. Please bring your own fire wood; on site fire wood cutting is not allowed. Keep cook fires at least twelve inches off the ground. Portable toilets are available. Drinking water is available in Cascade, three miles away.

There will be Rendezvous signs at the intersection the week of the Rendezvous.
